## INFRALERT Kick Off Meeting took place in Dresden at Fraunhofer IVI facilities on 15<sup>th</sup> - 16<sup>th</sup> June

The kick off meeting of the project INFRALERT, co-funded by the EU under the H2020 program, took place on 15th and 16th of June at the Fraunhofer Institute for Transportation and Infrastructure Systems IVI in Dresden/Germany. The 15 attendees from the seven partners consortium met together to discuss and agree on a detailed project work plan, to discuss about ongoing activities on requirement analysis and to present first results on state-of-the-art survey conducted during the first weeks of the project's lifetime. This was the first face to face meeting since the project start.
